APGO Announces Launch of New Website

Toronto, Ontario - The Association of Professional Geoscientists of Ontario (APGO) is pleased to announce the launch of its new website at www.apgo.net. The complete application package is available from the APGO office and will be available for downloading from the website on January 7, 2002. A revamped members-only area is also being designed and will be launched at the same time.
