### What are the categories?

- Judges' Favorite
- Science is fun shot
- Best image of our profession
- Best action shot
- Best overall photo



### What sorts of shots should you look for?

- ACTION shots of APGO geoscientists practicing the practice of professional geoscience
- Different activities, different seasons; all parts of Ontario, outside Ontario; indoors/underground, urban, rural or remote – the whole gamut
- Action that respects health and safety, the environment and the community
- Images of science in action and that is fun

### What format?

- Any format – digital, print, slide, etc.
- Digital submittals should be sent in by email as attached jpg or tiff files or burned onto a CD-R
- Prints and slides should be submitted by mail or courier as 4x6 or larger color prints
- Photos don't have to be current, but not be too ancient

### What is the deal?

- All entries must be received at the APGO office, in Toronto or Timmins no later than April 13, 2005
- All entries will be reviewed by a panel of judges
- All submitters will be asked to sign an entry/copyright release form
- **Material submitted will not be returned**
- Winners will be announced and prizes will be awarded at the AGM in May

### What are the prizes?

- A surprise (the winners in 2003 each received a gift certificate from Mountain Equipment Co-Op)
