Discipline Committee Pool of Members

The Discipline Committee of Association of Professional Geoscientists of Ontario ("APGO") is establishing a pool of members ("Discipline Pool") that will serve on an as needed basis on APGO Discipline Panels.

The Discipline Committee chair will select a panel of not less than three persons from the Discipline Pool to conduct a hearing related to matters of professional misconduct, negligence or incompetence against a member or a Certificate of Authorization holder.

The Discipline Pool will be composed of at least twenty-five individual volunteers who are APGO members in good standing with a minimum of ten years professional experience. We encourage volunteers from across Ontario and from different sectors of the geoscience community to participate. Members of the Discipline Pool will generally serve three-year terms; however, the actual time commitment will not be onerous. Familiarity with APGO By-laws and the draft Rules of Procedure of the Discipline Committee is a necessary asset. A one-day training session will be provided.

Individual practitioners and representatives of small and large public and private companies, the public and academic sectors, consulting firms and other interested members are invited to apply in writing for membership on the Discipline Pool, indicating their areas of practice and relevant experience.
