## NOTICE: APGO COUNCIL ELECTIONS – CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

In accordance with Section 19 of By-Law No. 8 - ELECTIONS, you are hereby advised that Nominations are now open for the upcoming election for APGO Council positions becoming vacant in 2006.

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Association will take place in Toronto on Thursday, June 1, 2006 and Close of Ballots will be on Friday, May 19, 2006, no more than 15 days before the AGM.

This notice, dated October 31, 2005, is in advance of the 120 days minimum notice period for Call for Nominations, as specified in the By-laws of the Association.

For each nominee, APGO must receive a letter of consent, a C.V. and a completed nomination form showing the support of 10 APGO members in good standing.

Only Practising, Temporary or Limited members may be nominated.

To be valid, a nomination must be received at the APGO office or by the Chair of the Nomination Committee – Mr. John Buckle, P.Ge., not later than noon on Friday, February 3, 2006 – at least 90 days before the Close of Ballots.

After the close of nomination, and upon announcement of the slate of nominees by the Nomination Committee, each member will receive ballot papers and voting instructions for the election.
