#### *About Mr. Robin Goad, P.Geo.*

Robin Goad is a Professional Geologist with more than 35 years of experience in the exploration and mining industries in Canada and internationally.

Robin is the President and CEO of London, Ontario based Fortune Minerals Limited, a Canadian mining and mineral development company that is listed for trading on the Toronto Stock Exchange and the OTC QX in the U.S.A. Robin founded Fortune in 1988 and had leading roles in assembling the Company's portfolio of mining and development assets through grass roots exploration and acquisitions. Fortune's diversified mining assets, include a 100% interest in the Revenue Silver Mine in southwest Colorado. Fortune also has two advanced development stage organic growth projects to build a diversified North American mining company. The NICO Gold-Cobalt-Bismuth-Copper Project has received its environmental assessment approval and key permits to build a mine and concentrator in Canada's Northwest Territories and its environmental assessment approval for a refinery in Saskatchewan to process NICO concentrate to high value metal and chemical products. The Arctos Anthracite Metallurgical Coal Project in British Columbia is a joint venture with Korean steel producer POSCO and is in the permitting process to construct a mine and railway extension to supply premium anthracite coal to the global steel and metals processing industries. With more than CDN\$ 250 million dollars of expenditures carried out on its principal assets, Fortune is positioned to become a reliable North American producer of important commodities critical to a growing world economy.

*The talk but will be focused primarily on project economics, the use of our unique commodities and the steps we have taken to advance our projects for development, i.e., the work required to build mines in today's environment.*

Robin Goad received his Master of Science Degree in Geology from the University of Western Ontario in 1987, and his Bachelors in 1981. Prior to founding Fortune, Robin worked for major mining companies, including Noranda and Teck and as a consultant to mid-tier and junior resource companies and government. Robin also serves as a director of the NWT & Nunavut Chamber of Mines and previously served as director for a number of other Canadian resource companies.

Robin and Fortune support education through sponsorship of undergraduate and graduate theses at Western and other universities, by hiring students for experience internships, participating in High School Coops, and through financial support for programs like Breakfast for Learning, Youth Abroad, and PDAC Mining Matters. Fortune participates in Women Immigrants to London, an organization that works with companies to provide work place experience to recent immigrants so that they can build a resume to be successful in finding permanent employment. Fortune is also a certified Bronze level company in the Canadian Council of Aboriginal Business' Progressive Aboriginal Relations Program.
